NINA

We're the exact opposite. Our friends know us very badly.

LÉO

I love dogs.

(A beat. Nina turns towards Léo. She doesn't really turn back.)

And cinema. And talking. Right now, for example, I'm talking. I'm having a bit of trouble stopping, suddenly.

RAPH

You know what? I think the blind date worked. Just... not in the intended direction.

NINA

Want to walk that imaginary dog? Now? It's a nice evening. Well, outside, there's an outside.
